Abstract

KSL has many resources and services to assist researchers at each of the research lifecycle stages. These services include providing specialized resources and support for literature reviews, and assisting with discovery, management, archiving, and visualization of research data. KSL also provides support for publishing venues identification to ensure high impact and visibility, research impact tracking, and planning strategies for preservation and dissemination of all research outputs.
