


How to Embed a Youtube Video into Drupal

Step 1) Navigate to the video on your web browser. Locate the video description.

Step 2) Click on the “Share” tab, then click “Embed”. Select your video size or resolution (e.g. 560 x 315) and copy the code in the box. This code is different for every video.

Step 3) Login to Drupal and navigate to the page you wish to edit.

Step 4) Under the “Body” section, hit the “Source” button (circled in red below) to change the editor type to source code. Locate the place on the page you wish to insert your video, then click there to bring the cursor there and paste the embed code from Youtube (circled in green). You can drag the video around later if you are not sure where to put it.

Step 5) Hit “Source” again and drag the iFrame (youtube video) around if you wish. Then hit “Save” to save the page. Your video should now be embedded into the Drupal page.
