### **ABOUT THE AWARD**

Graduate students are invited to participate in the CWRU <u>EMAE Graduate Student Teaching Award</u> sponsored by the Department of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering. This annual recognition was established to distinguish graduate students devoted to excellence in teaching.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

# Recipients must meet the Following Criteria

- 1. Candidate must be a current or recent graduate student at CWRU EMAE department.
- 2. Nomination from faculty advisor(s) is required for the candidate. Self-nominations will not be accepted.
- 3. Nominations should be based on teaching assistance during the 2020-21 academic year (Fall 2020 Spring 2021). Teaching roles include teaching assistance in any EMAE courses and research mentorship for undergraduate students in any EMAE labs.
- 4. Students who have not previously received the award will be given precedence.

#### **Prize**

The student awardees will receive:

- 1. A formal recognition certificate presented at the virtual Annual Graduate School Awards Ceremony.
- 2. A monetary prize.

### **Selection Process**

The EMAE Graduate Studies Committee and the EMAE Department Chair will make the selection.

### APPLY FOR THE RECOGNITION

The deadline for nominations is April 7, 2021.

- 1. To complete the nomination, e-mail the following as <u>a single PDF file</u> (*file name: Lastname\_Name.PDF*) no later than April 7.
  - i. A nomination letter from the faculty advisor briefly highlighting the teaching performance and impacts of the candidate.
  - ii. A two-page NSF Biosketch (see example: <a href="https://www.nsf.gov/bio/bioac/members/bio\_sketch/Raymond\_NSF\_Biographical\_Sketch.pdf">https://www.nsf.gov/bio/bioac/members/bio\_sketch/Raymond\_NSF\_Biographical\_Sketch.pdf</a>)
  - iii. Any supporting documents (not required, examples include letters from undergraduate students, comments in teaching evaluations)
- 2. Faculty are encouraged to nominate their graduate students for this recognition.
